

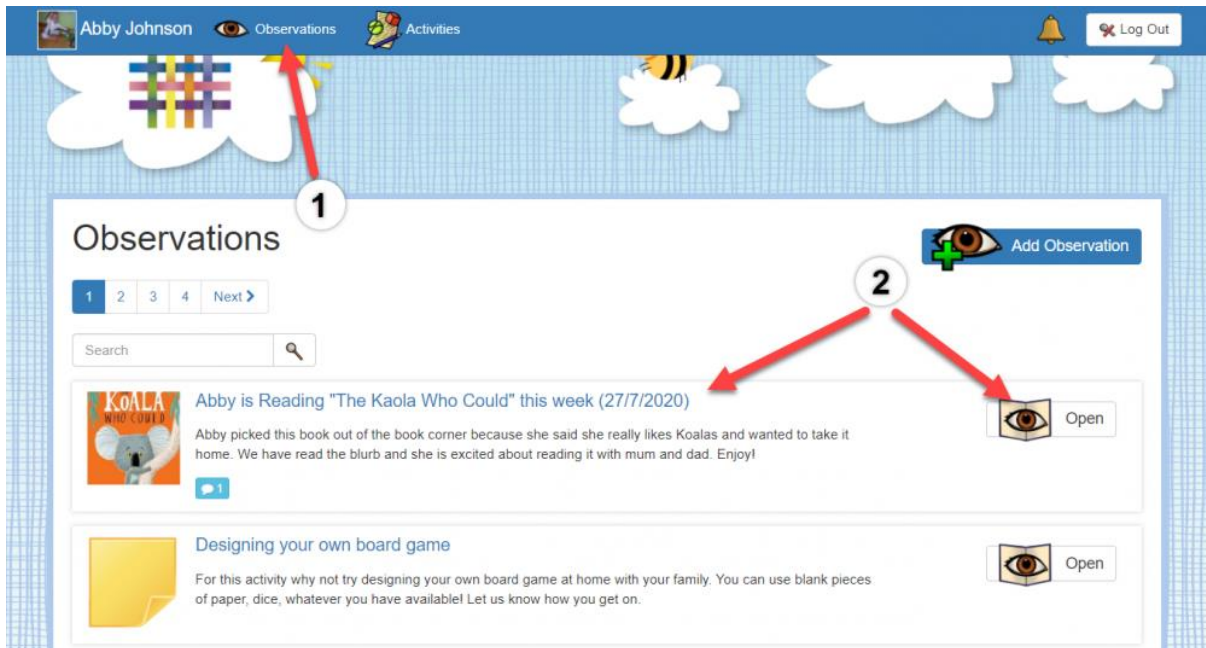
I'm going to show you how you can write observations on Tapestry. Observations are a way of sharing what you have been doing at home with your family.

Make sure you are logged into Tapestry first.

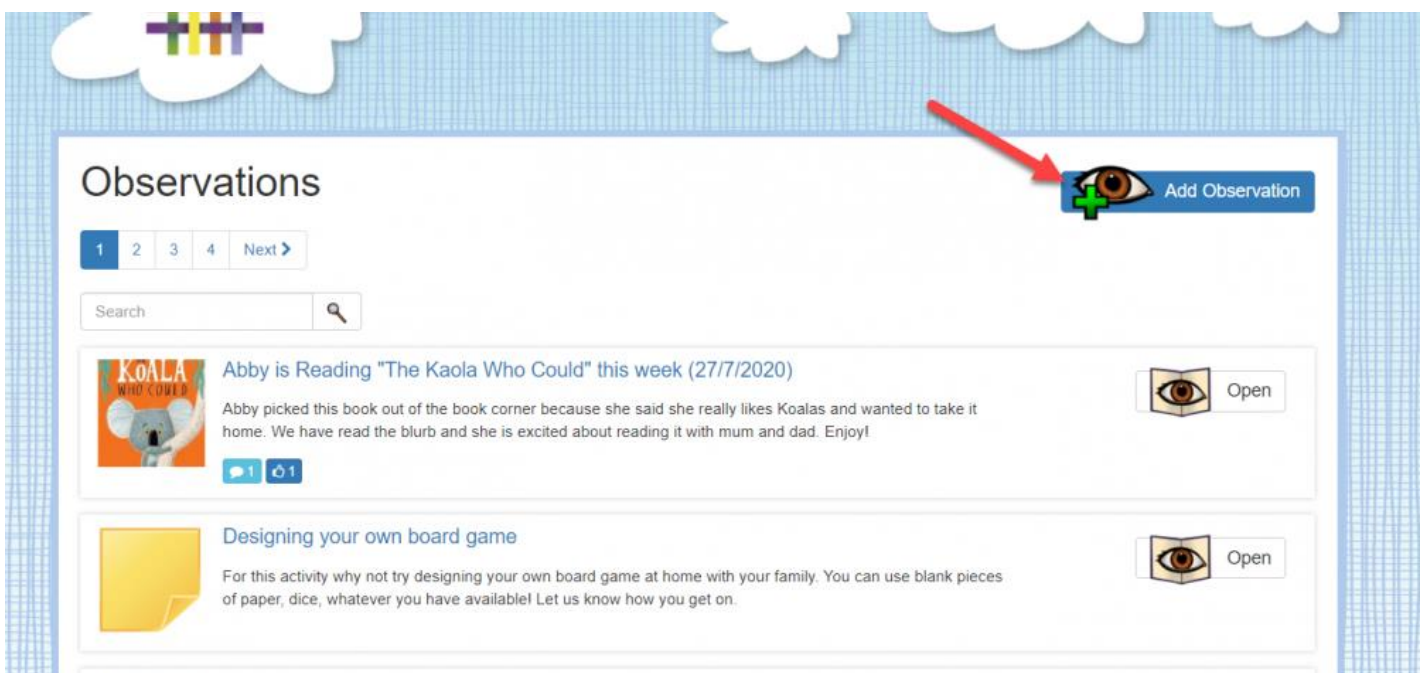
When you log into Tapestry you will start on the Observations page. This has a list of different observations made by you and your child's teacher.

If you get lost you can go back here by clicking the **Observations** button at the top of the screen next to your name. In the picture below it's being pointed at by the red number 1 arrow.

You can open any observation by clicking on it's title or the **Open** button, which you can see pointed out by the number 2 arrows.



If you want to write your own observation click the **Add Observation** button from the main Observations page.



Firstly, you need to write a title for your observation (shown by 1 in the picture below). Make sure to do this as you can't save your observation without adding a title!

You can then add the **Notes** you want to write (2) and pictures or videos (3). The observation **Notes** are where you can write what your child has done.

Once you're done, click the **Save** button at the bottom right (4). If you change your mind you can click **Cancel** (5) to go back to the main Observations page without saving.
