The performances will be dependent upon Covid restrictions, but as it stands we are able to go ahead and invite families in to view. This year, to ensure we are mindful of Covid, we are restricting to two guests per child. This means that children who live across two households will still be able to have both parents/guardians watch their performance. There will be sign in sheets as families arrive; we will unfortunately have to turn away anyone who is over the 2 guest limit. We are grateful for your understanding with this. As always, families are able to take photos and recordings of the performances for private viewing; we just insist that these are not circulated on social media.

Children are invited to wear something Christmassy on their performance day! Reception class teachers will send out additional information regarding costumes.

Most year groups will also have their Christmas party on the same day (class teachers will confirm). Please send your child with a small food donation (that doesn't need to be refrigerated) by Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> December.

We've also made our calls to Father Christmas who will be visiting all the children at school, and giving them a small gift, at the end of term. Class teachers will be able to tell you more if anything is missing, but for now, let's get back to November! 😊
