

Read, Lead, Succeed

At Dame Janet, we recognise the individual value and worth of every child and understand the significance of reading in tackling the effects of poverty; preparing our children for the future.



What is Read, Lead, Succeed?

Read, Lead, Succeed is a whole class reading approach which ensures that every child has access to age appropriate texts. Children are immersed in books which enrich the individual and develop knowledge, imagination and insight. Each text links directly to the learning in English lessons and is tied closely to the assessment foci, with tasks that are tailored to the needs of the individual.

How do our Early Readers learn?

We recognise that the ability to read is not developed overnight! At Dame Janet, we use 'Read Write Inc' to develop synthetic phonics over a series of stages that will, over time, lead to fluency and independent reading.

When is Read, Lead, Succeed taught at Dame Janet?

Our Early Years and Key Stage 1 pupils (Years 1-2) are immersed in 'Read Write Inc' lessons every morning. Once children have completed the Read Write Inc programme of study (usually during year 2), children begin their Read, Lead, Succeed lessons.

Our Key Stage 2 pupils (Years 3-6) are immersed in Read, Lead, Succeed lessons before morning playtime in order to continue the day in a world of colour, imagination and knowledge.

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An equal opportunity to have access to age appropriate, inspiring texts with tasks tailored to the individual needs of the pupil.
